## **Topic: How the author makes the article interesting?**

You need: an article, a song or a snap, a shot

## Clues:

- adverbs and adjectives
- comparison imaginary
- sensual vocabulary (words which appeal your senses)
- unusual words ( help your intention)
- formal and informal language
- long or short sentences (mixture is the best)
- punction ( colon, semicolon, comma)

Task: Read your paragraph and list the features which make the text more interesting

Examples: words explaining the weather blizzard heatwave drought gales cold and sunny spells flood avalanche mud slide high humidity stuffy

Task: The weather effects on human history Examples: cold - punishment changes - rats weather - the fall of the Roman Empire

Phrases: Am I right in thinking that ... Can you expand a bit more on that...





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You have mentioned that... I'd just like to make sure I understand... Is that what you're saying? Can you explain what you meant by...? Perhaps I missed something but... I just pick up on...

Find in the text: Linking words and thoughts.

Good point: lyrics, songs and music

Before you listen: Discuss who is in the picture? A famous singer? What do you know about him/ her? Have you ever listened to his/her song? Why do you like him/ her? What kind of music style does he/ she represent?

Music generally: Talk about themes of songs, mood music, a (charity) concert

During: Listen to the song. Choose the right words. Complete the right word.

After Check you answers. Read and try to understand the song/ lyrics. Find grammar rules. Work with vocabulary. Is there a change of meaning/ a metaphor?
